Graduated from an accredited MA program (ROUTE 1 - Education)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training programs must be accredited by an agency approved by the DOE** • Training programs must have 720 clock hours of instruction, including at least 160 clock hours of externship** • If graduated more than 4 years ago, must also have 3 out of the last 5 years of work experience as an MA in both clinical and administrative areas 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a recent graduate, final transcript from the school showing graduation from an MA program • If graduated more than 4 years ago: a copy of the transcript is acceptable and documented work experience (verified by AMT)
Graduated from a military medical services training program (ROUTE 2 - Military)	Same as above	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joint Services Transcript • DD214 (if discharged) • Last 5 evaluations
Have been working as an MA for 5 out of the last 7 years (ROUTE 3 – Work Experience)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Work experience must include both clinical and administrative areas 2. Work requirement is full-time. Part-time experience must equal total full-time requirement. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A copy of a high school diploma • Documented work experience (verified by AMT)
Have been instructing in an accredited MA program between 1 and 5 years? (ROUTE 4 - Instructor)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be currently instructing in an accredited MA program 2. Must have completed a course of instruction in a healthcare discipline 3. Must have 5 years of teaching experience in MA, including both clinical and administrative areas 4. If less than 5 years but more than 1 year of teaching experience, must also verify 3 years of MA experience, including both clinical and administrative areas in your work history 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A copy of the transcript • Documented teaching and work experience (work experience is verified by AMT). All teaching and work requirements are understood to be full-time.
