## How to get your own credential (or certification in a nutshell)

### Apply online.

1. Go to [www.americanmedtech.org](http://www.americanmedtech.org) and under "Get Certified" choose "Eligibility".
2. Select the certification of your choice and review the eligibility requirements to make sure you meet the criteria to apply.
3. If you meet the requirements, go to "Apply Online". Follow the instructions to enter your information.
4. Complete an application. It is important for you to connect yourself to your school under "Allied Health Training" Please note that if you are choosing the "Education" route, you don't need to enter anything in the "Employment History" section of the application.
